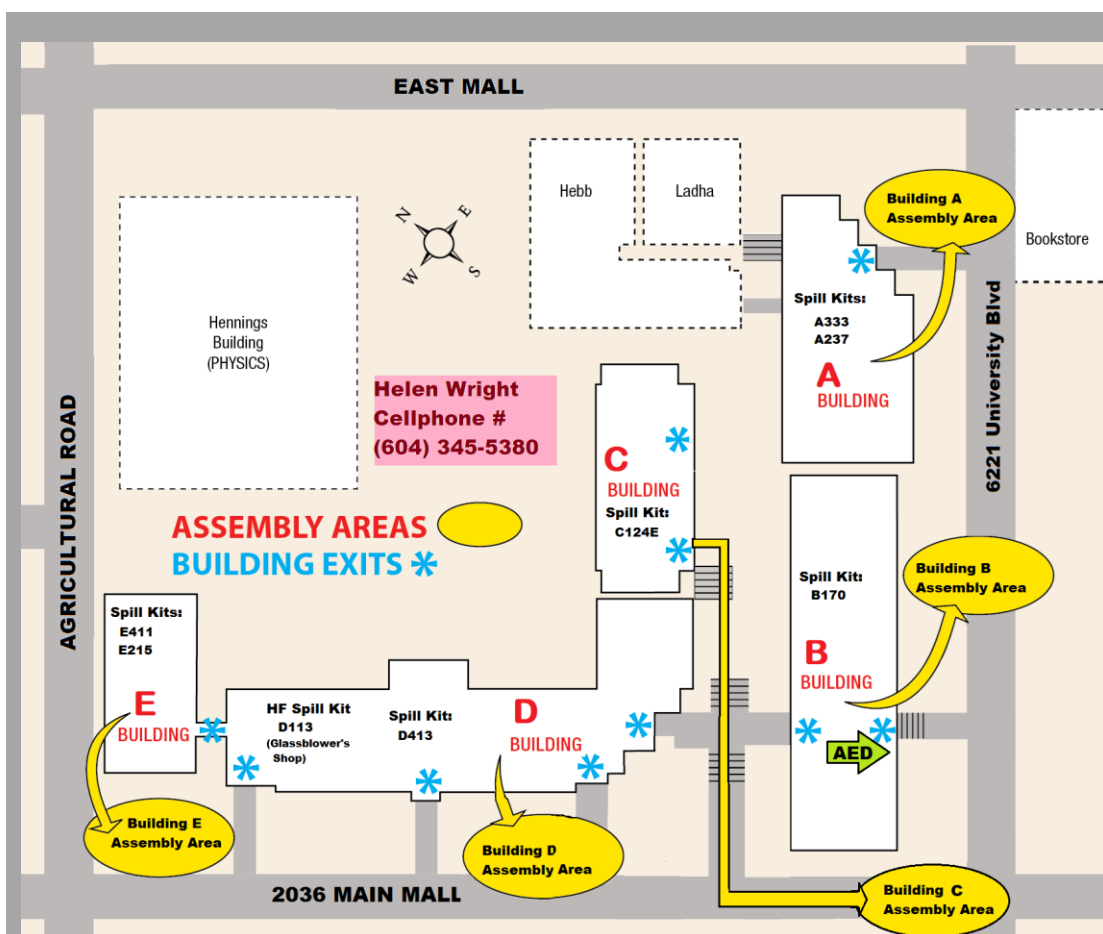

Clearly state incident location and nature of Emergency.

First Aid Tips:	First Aid Response:
BURNS:	Flush injury for 20 minutes with cool water.
CUTS:	Stop the bleeding with direct hand pressure.
FALL/UNCONCIOUSNESS:	Since there may be serious unseen injuries, DO NOT MOVE the patient unless there is a life-threatening situation. Keep the patient warm.
CHEMICAL EXPOSURE (eyes/skin):	Flush injury for 20 minutes with cool water.

- SPILL KITS:**
- Are located outside of Rooms: A237 A333, B170, C124E, D413, E215 and E411
 - Hydrofluoric Acid Kit is located: IN the Glassblower's Shop D113
 - DO NOT WORK ALONE!
- For spill clean-up advice, contact: ChemDept Safety Office (7-5216) or Risk Mgmt (2-2029)
 - For spills greater than 1L, contact 911 for back-up assistance.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS are for use on SMALL FIRES only. DO NOT WORK ALONE!

- FIRE BELL RINGING:**
- Intermittent = Standby alert
 - Solid ring = Evacuate
- Stop all procedures - turn off all appliances and gas valves.
 - After the last person has left the room, CLOSE ALL DOORS (DO NOT LOCK).
 - EXIT BUILDING IMMEDIATELY - DO NOT USE THE ELEVATOR.
 - DO NOT RETURN until the Fire Warden has announced "ALL CLEAR"
